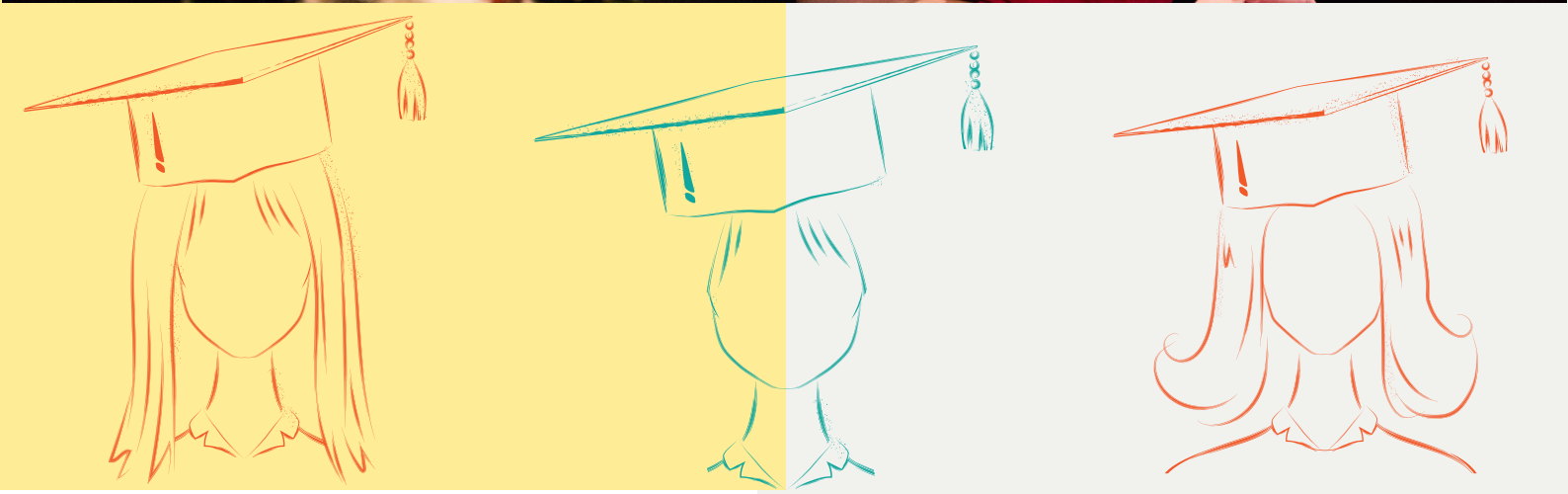

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Every year the Foundation grants two music scholarships to gifted and talented students based on academic merit and financial assistance.

The Scholarship provides a sum of \$2000 in the first year of the program (Year 7) and \$500 in the consecutive years up to their last year of High School (Year 12). The Scholarship aims to assist with expenses related to musical studies and education expenses such as;

- Purchase of a musical instrument
- Stationary and books
- Excursions and camps
- Laptop
- Uniform
- Others

Mr John Gillon, Chairman of the Churchlands Senior High School Foundation and also Head Boy of the Class of 1968, encourages alumni, parents and the community to support the Foundation. This is to increase the number and range of scholarships awarded each year. Students benefit directly from funds raised through different campaigns and events.

Since its introduction students Guy Archibald, Kaiya O'Brien, Benjamin Macdonald and Bethany Jolly Fuentes have been the recipients of the musical scholarship.

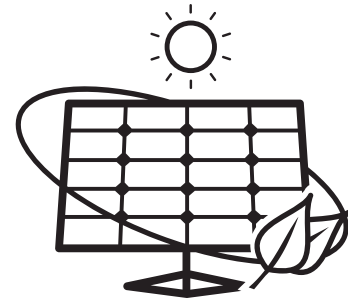

SOLAR POWER PROJECT

In October 2016, the Churchlands Senior High School Foundation launched the Solar Power to Scholarships project. Parents, Alumni and staff were in attendance and showed encouraging support for this exciting initiative.

The Foundation has undertaken to raise funds and pay for the installation of solar panels to reduce the School's power costs. The net outcome is that Churchlands students will receive scholarships and benefits each year equivalent to the amount of power costs saved by the School as a direct result of the installation of a solar power system.

The night was filled with great performances from our very talented music students and presentations from the School Principal, the Foundation Chairman and the Solar Power expert.



As a result the Foundation has already received donations for this project and would like to thank all of those who have contributed so far.

As part of the project, the Foundation has established an annual giving campaign that is seeking support of all current parents and Alumni. Donations of all amounts will be gratefully received and acknowledged.

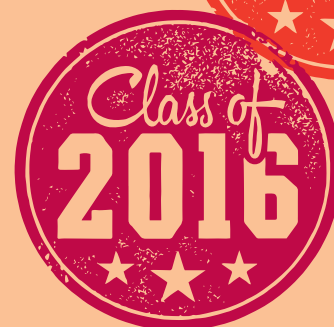
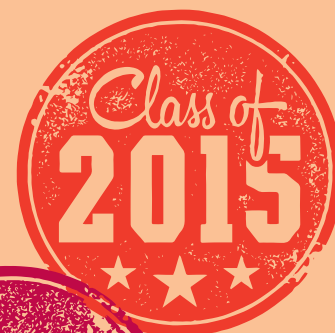

Churchlands Alumni and Foundation are planning a special dinner for Head Boys, Girls and Duxes but we are missing some contact details.

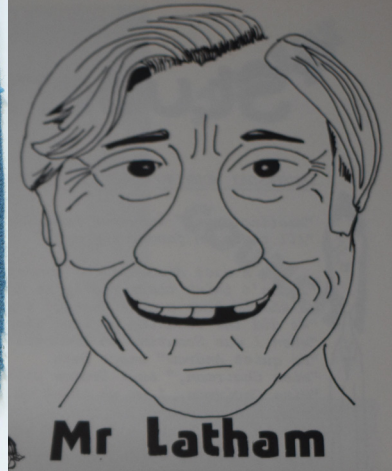

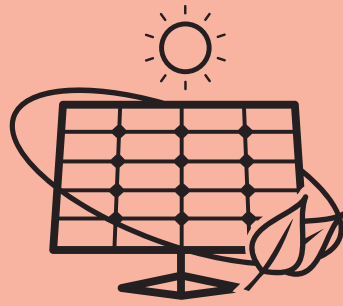
